

# The guide to setup Citrix on the iPad

## Installing the Citrix Receiver

Go to the app store and search for the application called "Citrix Receiver", after the search is complete click on and install the application (see picture below).

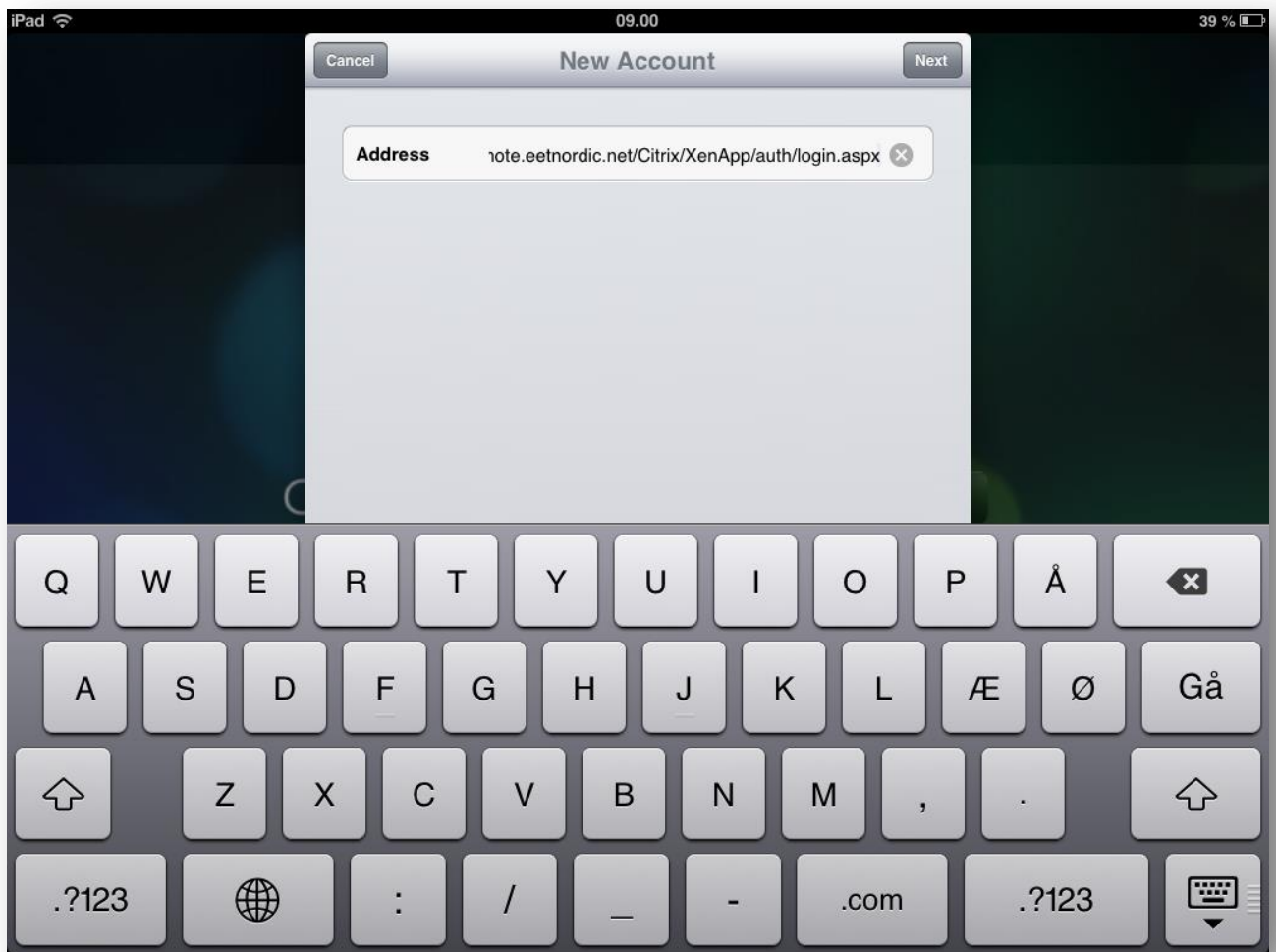


## Setting up the Citrix Receiver for EET

Now start the newly installed Citrix Receiver application. The first thing you will see is two buttons “Add Account” and “Try Demo”, you need to **click on “Add Account”**.

You will be asked for an address, here you will need to write the address below, exactly as it is written here. The address you need to write is: <https://remote.eetnordic.net/Citrix/XenApp/auth/login.aspx> (see picture below)

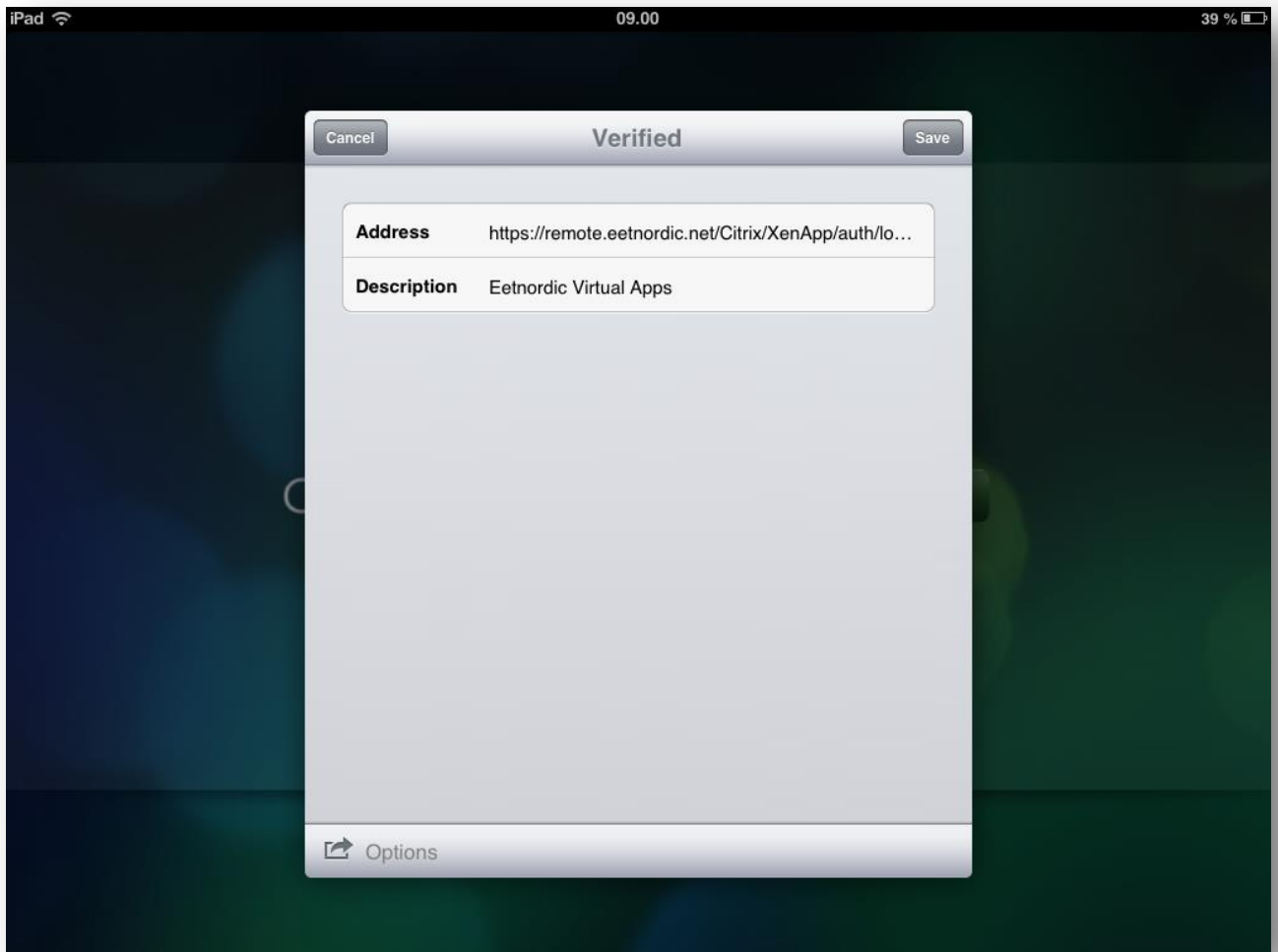
Now click next

Now on the next screen shows if the address was verified as a Citrix server. So if you get an error here, check the address for errors (see picture below to see what it should look like, when verified).

Now click save, the account has now been setup on the iPad.



## Connecting to an application using the Citrix Receiver

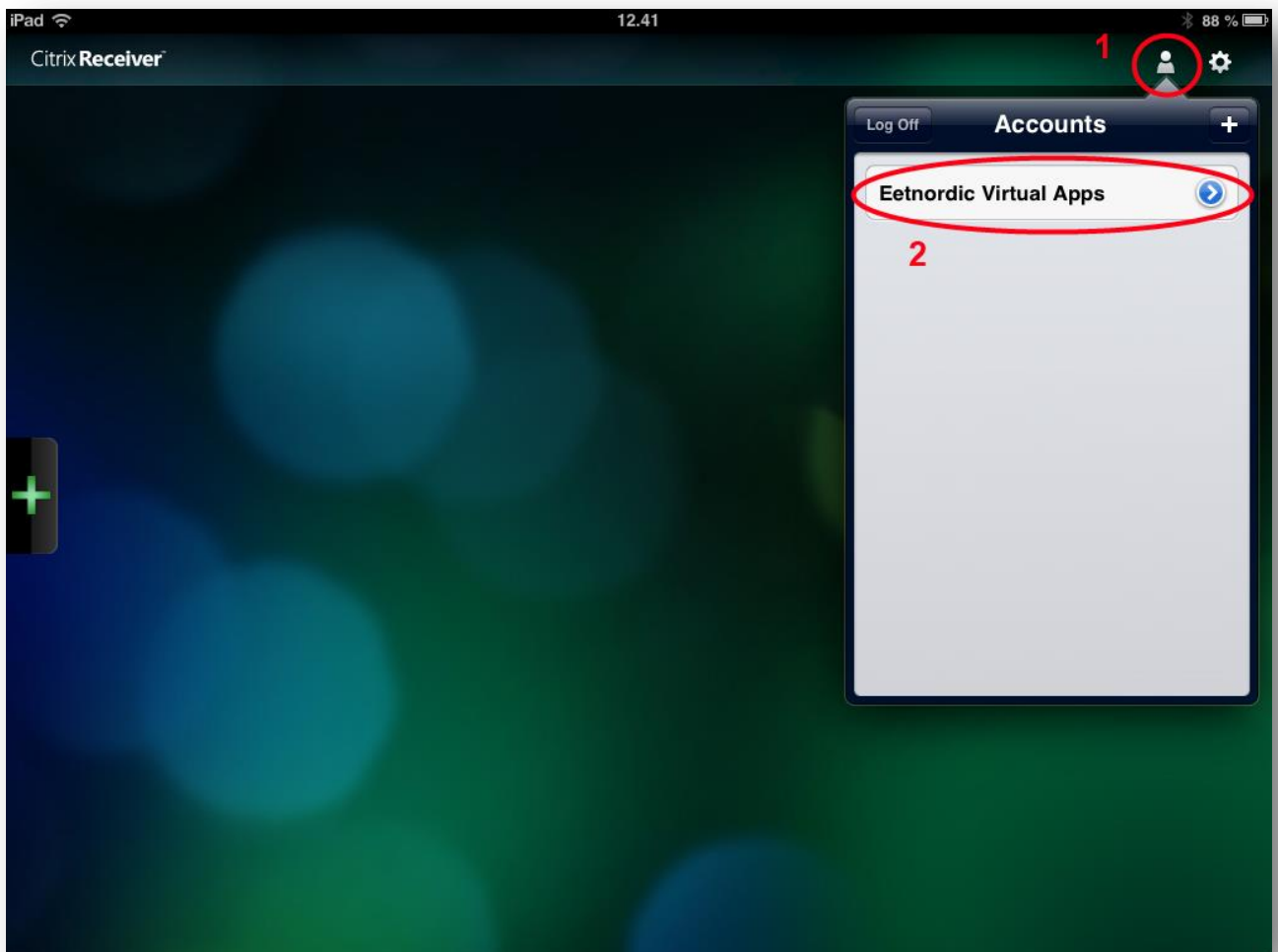
We have now configured an account in the Citrix Receiver application, now we need to connect to an EET application using it.

The first thing you will need to do after starting the Citrix Receiver application is access the logon screen, to do this follow these steps:

1. Click on the Accounts icon
2. Click on the Eetnordic Virtual Apps account

The picture below show where you need to click to do this to follow step 1 and 2.

If you have just configured the account you will already be at the logon screen.

At the logon screen you will be asked for your RSA logon information's, which means your username and pin code.

SMS example on username and pin code: tur-dk and 342195

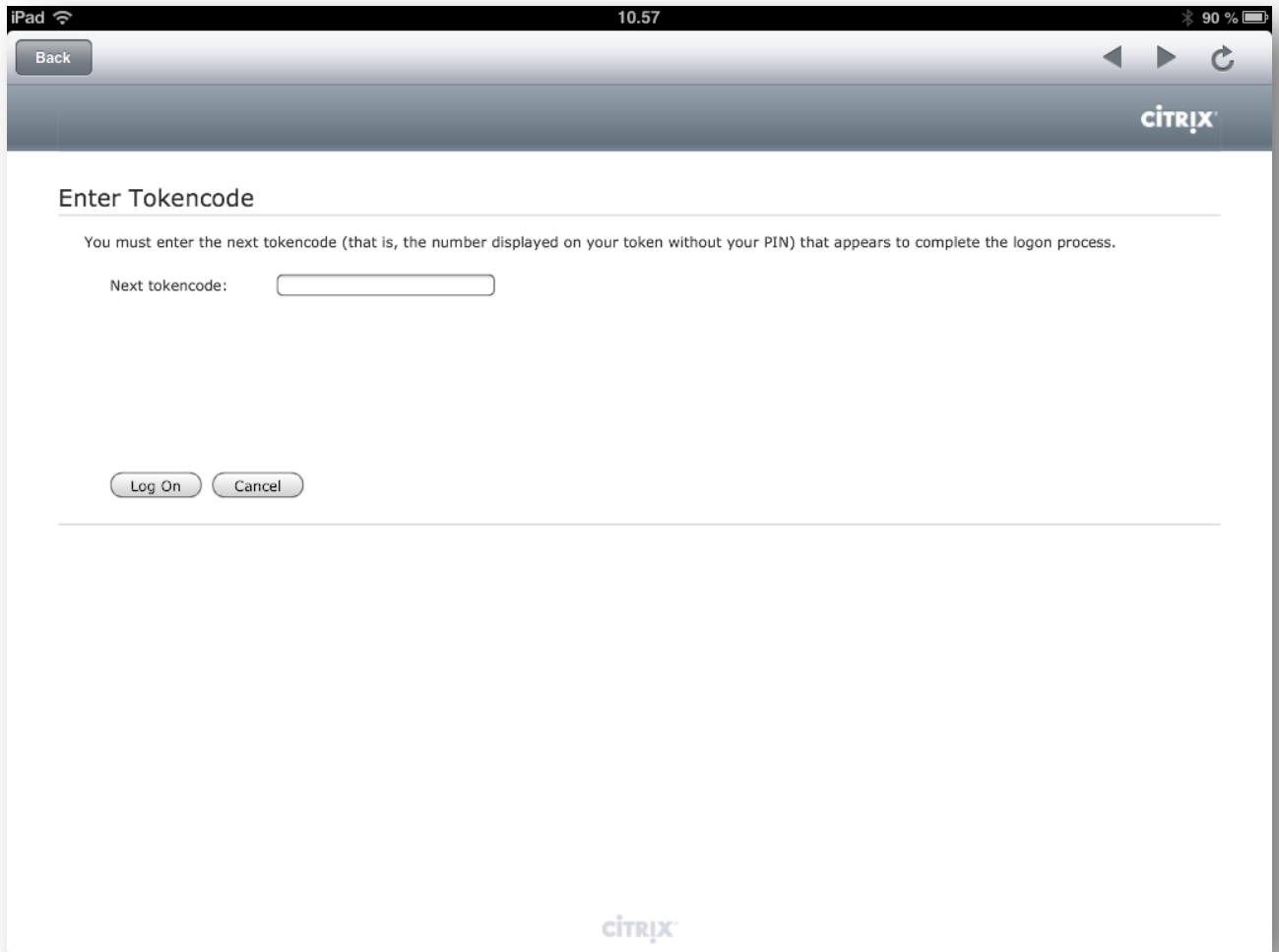
RSA Key example on username and pin code: tur-dk and 342195 + numbers from RSA Key

If you are not configured to use the RSA logon method, then please contact the IT department.

Now type you username and pincode and click on "Log On" (see picture below).



If you are using the RSA SMS solution, then you will be prompted for the SMS token code in the screen below.



You will not see the screen if you are using a physical token key.

**OBS: If this is the first time you logon with the RSA, then you may be asked for a password. This is your windows password and you will only be asked for it one time.**

You are now logged in to EET's Citrix farm on your iPad and can start the applications that you have available to you (see pictures below).
